

Boat Park FAQs

1. How are Boat Park Fees calculated?

Boat park fees are charged depending on size

£50 Canoe (no trailer)	£70 Trailer
£100 Rowing boat < 15ft	£150 Dinghy > 15ft (or powered)
£210 Small cruiser up to 20ft	£250 Large cruiser over 20ft

2. When are the annual fees due?

Fees are due on the 1st May each year. In the first year these charges are calculated pro-rata

3. Can the fees be paid in instalments and how do I pay?

Boat fees must be paid in a single payment by bank transfer or debit card

4. How do I cancel my Boat Park Agreement?

If you do not wish to renew your boat park space at the end of the season please ensure that you give us the required 28 days notice of termination in writing as required under the terms of your Agreement. **Please note that no refunds are made if the Boat Park agreement is terminated by the boat owner after renewal**

6. Do I need insurance?

All boats in the boat park require 3rd party insurance

7. Is the Boat Park secure?

The boat park is in a secure compound and is covered by an alarm system. CCTV covers the Boat park entrance. We recommend that any fuel tanks or movable items are removed from your boat or secured in the cabin.

8. Can I sell my boat on its Boat Park space?

You may sell your boat on its Boat Park space with our agreement, but the buyer will need to sign a Boat Park Agreement if they intend to keep the boat in the Boat Park and must be a Holiday Park customer.

10. Can I access my boat in the winter?

An additional lock is put on the boat park gates which customers do not have a copy of so during the winter it is only possible for **occasional** access to your boat. Please call the Park Office on 01628 823501 to arrange this.

11. Is electricity supplied to the Boat Park

No. There is no electricity supplied

12. Do I need to keep my boat in good repair?

Yes. All boats that fall into disrepair may have their Boat Park Agreement cancelled. Please visit you boat regularly to ensure this does not happen.

13. If I sell my caravan do I need to leave the Boat Park?

Yes. If you sell your caravan on the Holiday Park you will need to leave the Boat Park at the end of the season.
